<b>THEME</b>	<b>AXE 10</b> Build up human capacities through student and professional mobility and with a better command of foreign languages spoken in the Caribbean. It is one of the six strategic priorities of the Interreg programme
<b>SPECIFIC OBJECTIVES</b>	<b>SO 15 and SO 16</b> Enhance exchange programs mainly among students and professionals, reinforce the mastery of the languages spoken within the Caribbean, as a tool to get easier access to tertiary education and to enter the Labour market successfully with all required skills
<b>SCHEDULE</b>	From January 1st, 2019 to December 31st, 2021 (36 months) – An extension of the ELAN programme until 31 <sup>st</sup> July 2022 is under review.

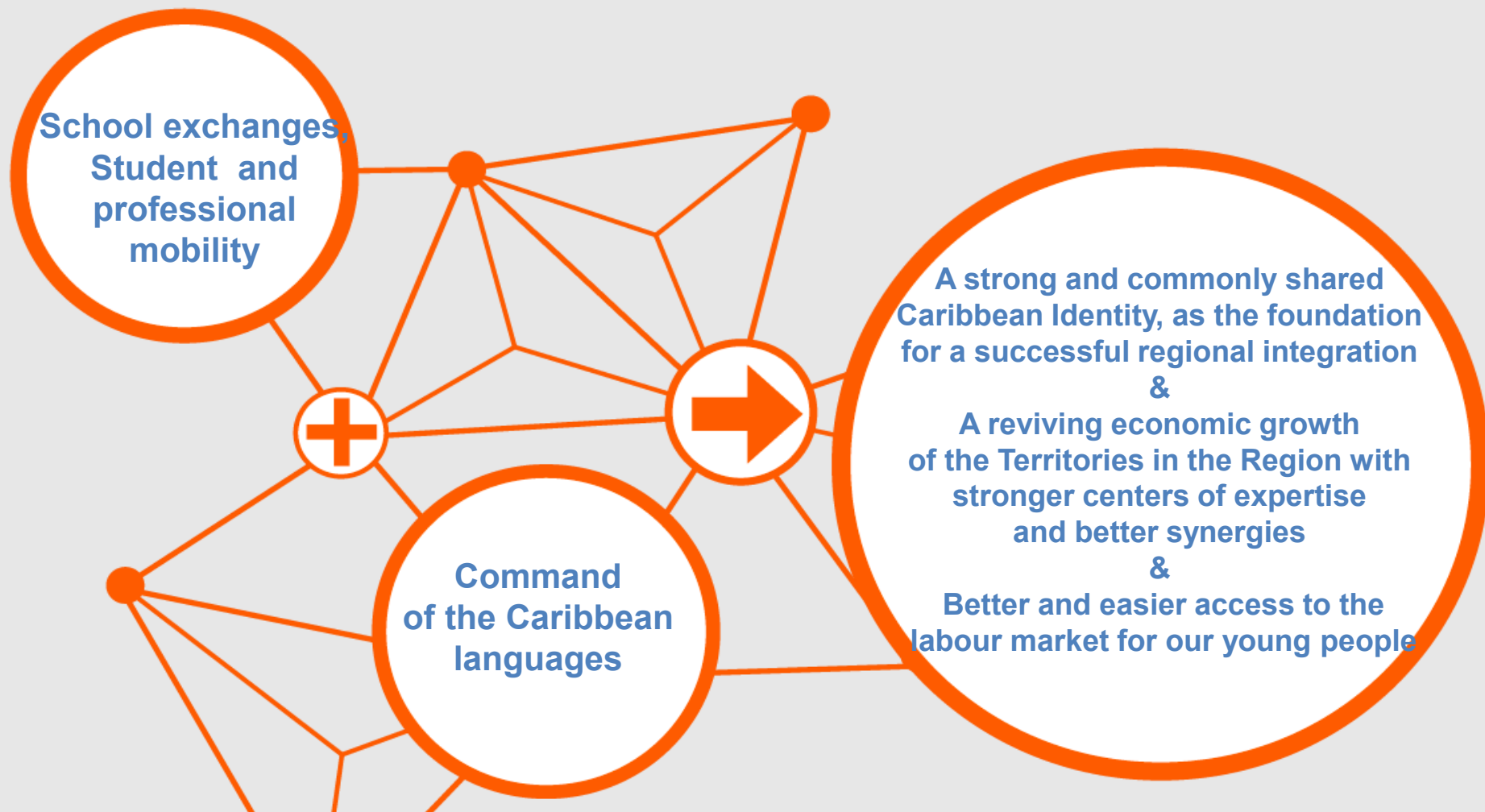


## The main objectives of the ELAN (MOMENTUM) project:

Internships, school exchanges and visibility of training maps, Teacher workshops linguistic certification




**2020**

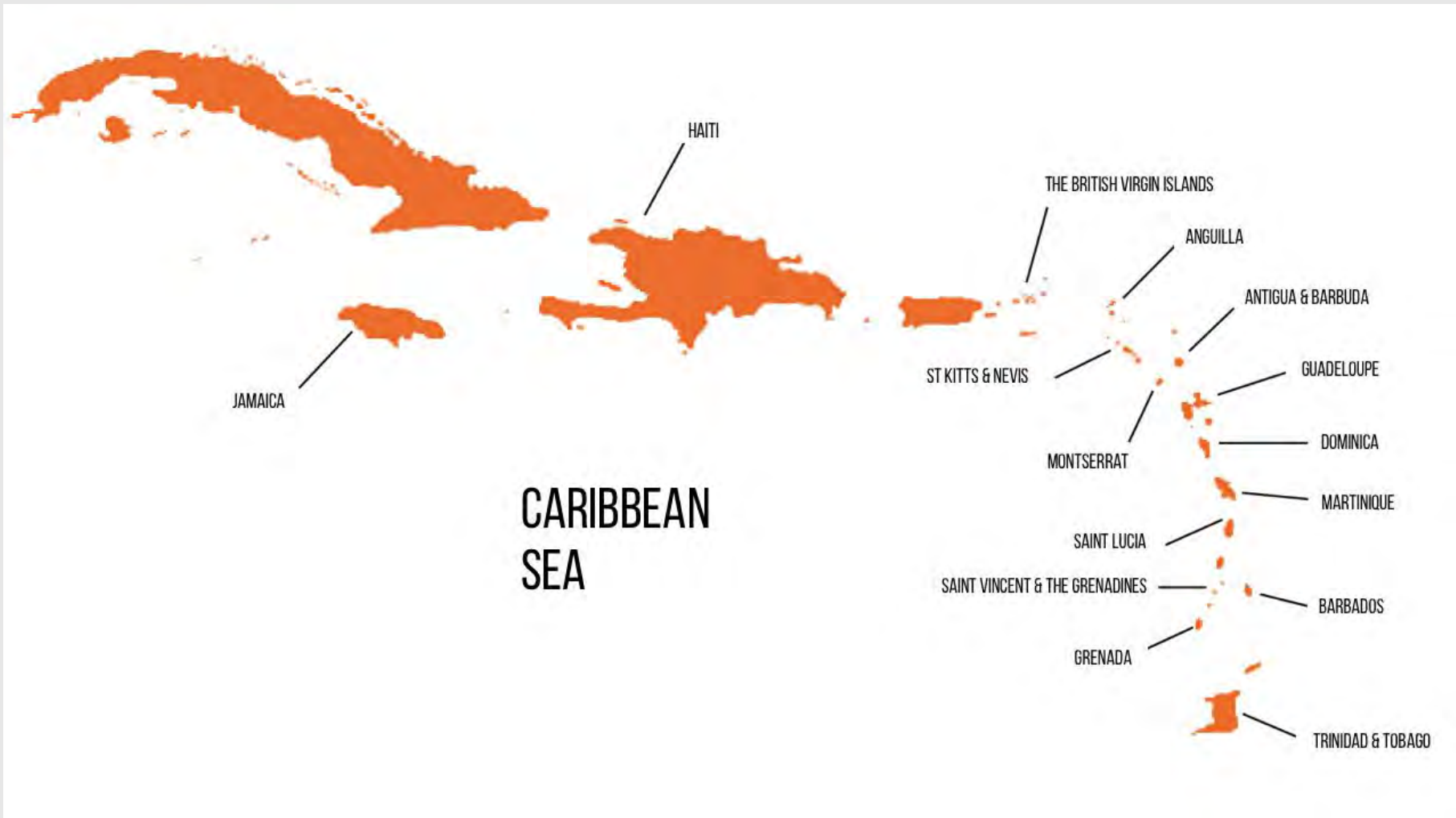

## ATTRACTIVITY

- Reinforced attractiveness of the Region (Human Capacity building, better skills, enhanced qualified teachers and education professionals, stronger regional expertise and innovation potential, especially in the field of Tourism)

## ECONOMIC GROWTH

- Increasing student mobility & collaborative research
- Strengthen mobility among universities and tertiary education
- Reach more effective contribution of European programs for mobility to the Region.
- Exchange of best practices– Innovative teaching approaches– Mutualized resources for a sustainable cooperation

## LANGUAGES

- Better command of languages spoken in the Caribbean
- Languages as a tool to acquire new skills and get easier access to tertiary education and to the Labour market

# A FINANCIAL SUPPORT TO ENCOURAGE THE ELAN MOBILITY PROGRAM

According to the program, this amount includes :

- A contribution to travel costs according to social criteria
- A flat contribution to the cost of living (€ 700/month)
- Coverage of registration fees through the granted scholarship
- Coverage of training costs for interns and participants in linguistic, cultural and pedagogical workshops
- Complementary measures to ease mobility and make it a successful experience!

includes six main activities:**

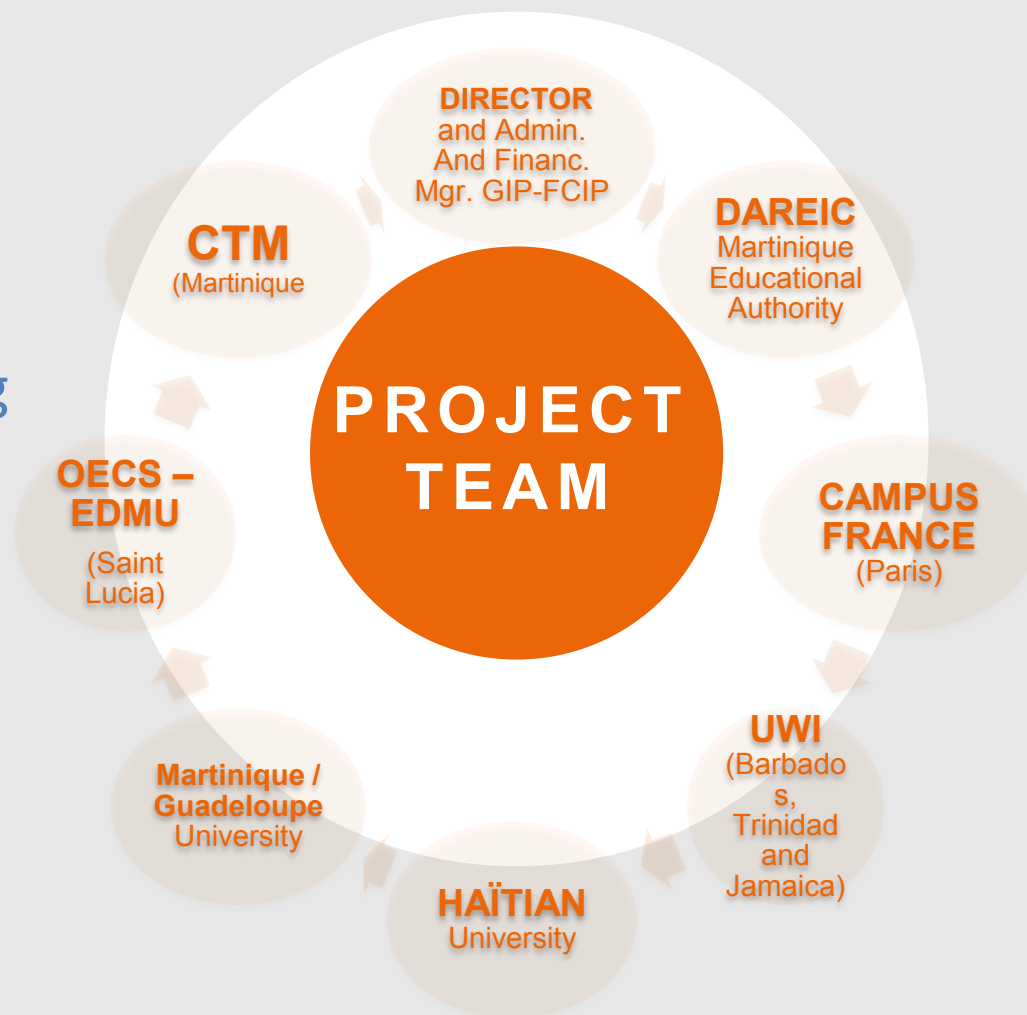
1. Support sustainable School partnerships

5. Promote Higher Education
6. Encourage Mobility of Interns and Technical Vocational Training Students (jobseekers)
